### **LEVY FACTS**

- 1. This levy will provide local funding for our schools over the next **four years** beginning January 2025.
- Levy passage is necessary to receive state levy equalization dollars.
   Tonasket is eligible for approximately \$1,000,000 per year of levy equalization funds. We will not receive these state funds unless we pass a levy!
- 3. The district has proposed a levy of \$1.85 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. The EP&O Levy replaces the **expiring two year** EP&O Levy approved by voters in 2022.
- 4. The Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy will be used to maintain current programs and fund what the state does not consider "Basic Education". Many programs we offer and the community expects are not technically considered "Basic Education" by the state of Washington. Our levies have supported and will continue to support the following: buildings/grounds, special programs/staffing, co-curricular/extracurricular activities, and curriculum/technology.
- 5. The funds generated by our local levy and state levy equalization are approximately 12% of the school district's budget.
- 6. Senior Citizens/Disabled Person Tax Exemption. Citizens over 61 years of age, who earn less than \$40,000 per year or are unable to work due to disability, may qualify to receive an exemption. For exemption information, call the Okanogan County Assessor at 509-422-7190


