WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

- US CITIZENS
- WASHINGTON STATE RESIDENT WITH PROOF OF A PHYSICAL ADDRESS FOR 30 DAYS
- WILL BE 18 YEARS OLD BY NOVEMBER ELECTION DAY
- NOT A FELON IN PRISON OR ON PAROLE. ONCE RIGHT TO VOTE IS RESTORED MUST RE-REGISTER
- NOT DISQUALIFIED FROM VOTING BY A COURT ORDER

HOW TO REGISTER:

- DEADLINE FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION IS OCTOBER 9, 2017; OCTOBER 30 FOR IN PERSON REGISTRATION
- ONLINE: GO TO myvote.wa.gov YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE A WA DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBER OR A STATE ID NUMBER OR THE LAST FOUR DIGITS OF YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER
- PRINT: YOU CAN PRINT A BALLOT IN ONE OF 18 LANGUAGES AT vote.wa.gov
- MAIL: YOU CAN REQUEST TO HAVE A BALLOT MAILED TO YOU AT sos.wa.gov
