- a) Students will show a growth of at least 62.5% on each unit of their math course measured from their pre-test to their post test. Growth in each CCSS category will be measured to align with our deconstruction of the CCSS for Math. Further, Students will meet or exceed their growth goal for their content specific NWEA from Fall to Spring. Finally, an honest attempt to include parents in goal setting activities will be made.
- b) 80% of Freshman and Sophomores will meet or exceed their reading goals as measured by NWEA
By the end of the 2018-19 year, Social Studies and English will develop a shared writing assessment including components from AVID assessments
- c) For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the Science PLC will develop assessments to determine student achievement on NGSS. These assessments will be analyzed to determine strengths and weaknesses in current curriculum and practices. This data will help guide the 2018 - 2019 science curriculum adoption. Over the next two years, these assessments will be analyzed to determine the effectiveness of new curriculum on student achievement.
- d) All CTE instructors will implement at least one leadership event from their perspective CTSO's into their classroom curriculum. 80% of students in all classes will complete a leadership assignment by May 1, 2019.
